

## Message in the Apple

On April 9, 2016 I had the craving for an apple and picked one up. As I was about to take a bite I noticed strange markings on the apple. The Hebrew letters Yud Shin Yud were visible on the apple!

ישׁוּ

“Yud Shin Yud” spells “Yishai”, which translates into the name “Jesse”. You may recall that Jesse was King David’s father. The name Jesse means “God Exists” or “Gift of God”.

I recognized “Gift of God” as one of the meanings of my name, Mike. Mike means “Who is like God?” and also “Gift of God”.

If you read the letters upside down it becomes “Yud Vav Chet Yud”, the name “Yochi”, which is short for “Yochai”. Yochai means “God Lives”.

Yochi is written in Hebrew on my shofar!
