

# You're Going to Israel!

I saw the form of a man with a suitcase:

I was prompted to turn around and look at the sky again.

I saw Hebrew letters in the sky! I recognized the hand (which translates to Yod) and the Resh. I got the feeling right away that these letters would spell “Israel”, but did not believe it!

I went back into work and started researching these letters.



Let's examine them!

The first symbol that caught my attention was the hand/.  
The Hebrew letter 'Yod' means "hand" and it looks like this:






The second symbol is the Shin, which translates to English "S".

The Shin is a little difficult to see, but it is there.



The third letter is Resh, which translates to English "R".



The fourth letter is Aleph. You can see the diagonal leg.



The fifth letter is Lamed. This letter is difficult to see. If you look close you can see where the cloud letter comes up on the right, moves to the left, and then continues to rise on the left.

Here is the word "Israel" in Hebrew letters:

ישראל

Like I said, I did not believe it. I said "Lord, how can I be sure that this is from You?"  
I heard an immediate response:

*"...Come back outside! "*

As I walked through the lobby to go outside I heard The Lord say:

*"...I will show you My Name in the sky, and then you will know that it is Me..."*

I walked outside into the parking deck. After I got half way across I turned around and felt my head being moved upwards.

At 12:33pm I saw the Aleph in the sky!

The letter Aleph is the first letter of the Hebrew alphabet and means "The Father"!



Around 2:45 that afternoon, I was summoned outside again. As I stood at the side of the parking deck my gaze was drawn out into a wooded area. There I saw what appeared to be the figure of a large man standing in the trees!

For comparison, the lines on the lower left are the rails for an elevated train line. The man was as tall as the trees around him. I would estimate his height at about thirty feet!
